EYFS Supervision of children throughout the school day

Before School

From 8.00 am onwards, children in the EYFS (Nursery and Reception) are either accompanied to Reception or Nursery by their parents/carers or alternatively, if dropped at the main school entrance, they are supervised by a member of staff at the 'Magic Carpet' and are then accompanied to Nursery by a member of staff or to Reception by a Year 6 Prefect. Once children reach the Nursery or Reception classrooms, they are in the care of the EYFS staff.

During the School Day

From the moment the children in the EYFS arrive in their settings, they are supervised by their form teacher and classroom assistants until 3.30 pm.

For the academic year 2016-2017 there is one form teacher and one part-time classroom assistant in Reception. In Nursery there is one Nursery teacher, one Level 3 support teacher, who is also EY SENCO and one full-time Nursery assistant, training towards Level 3 Diploma. When the children are time-tabled to be taught by other specialist members of Prep Staff (Music, PE, etc. the children are never left unattended. One teacher hands over to the next at lesson change. The classroom assistants accompany the children to other lessons.

After School

Children throughout the Prep School may stay in After School Care every day until 6.00 pm. From 3.30 pm to 4.00 pm the children in EYFS and KS1 are supervised by a member of staff from EYFS or KS1, on a rota. They are in Prep Hall for a story, until 4.00 pm

From 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm, the children are in the care of our After School Care Supervisor and two assistants.
