Beechwood is a Catholic school, originally founded by the Sisters of the Sacred Heart, where children of all faiths benefit from the school's traditional values. The Beechwood Code helps pupils to understand what we expect of them. From their early years through to the oldest in the school, Beechwood boys and girls learn to respect the feelings of other people and to show consideration for each other.

Older children become playground buddies and later school prefects, giving them a sense of responsibility as they recognise that their actions are seen and emulated by younger pupils.

In Form Time and in School Council, pupils learn to listen and to develop their own opinions. In our small classes, everyone has the chance to speak and to feel that their contribution is valued. The House system also encourages everyone to take part in events and feel part of a team.
