Netball

On Thursday the U8/9s took part in matches against Hilden Grange teams. It was a bitterly cold afternoon and all the girls did extremely well to battle through and keep warm. The scores were as follows; in the first game 1-0, second game 0-0 and the third game finished 0-0. We made progress in each match especially in the third game where Esme was so close to scoring, five times. It was a great shame that no goals were scored as Beechwood deserved to win the game. A special mention to Ella-Rose who was fantastic at intercepting the ball, Aliya who whizzed around the court and Penny who marked her opponent well, making it difficult for them to get free.

Tag Rugby

On Wednesday 9th January, our U10/11s travelled to Sacred Heart Wadhurst for a series of Tag Rugby fixtures. Team 1 demonstrated excellent running and attacking to create scoring opportunities across their two matches. Unfortunately the boys' efforts in defence were unrewarded as SH were equally as dynamic in attack. Team 1 tied one match and lost the other, but our try scorers were; Jojo (3), Ashton (1), Benjamin (2), Noah (3), Ribhav (1). Team 2 also played two matches in which they demonstrated a sterner defensive unit, however mistakes in the scoring area of the pitch saw them draw one and lose the other of the matches. Rugby

On Wednesday the U12/13s travelled to Radnor House for their first Rugby fixture of the year. We played an U13 team first, and after a tight beginning of the game Max went over the try line to cancel out a Radnor opener. We became a lot more determined, but errors in attack meant we couldn't build on our score. Radnor's power and strength gave them victory. We then faced an U12 team, who were a lot more effective in passing the ball. We demonstrated a physical dominance over Radnor however, despite a dynamic run and try from Michael, Radnor's ball movement led them to victory in the second match.

Tag Rugby

On Thursday the U9s travelled to Fosse Bank for a Tag Rugby fixture. We settled into our attacking play quickly and raced into a 6-2 lead after the first quarter. The second quarter was end to end, with both teams showing attacking prowess but also fragility in defensive areas. At the end of this quarter we led 11-6. We showed more effective, and direct running in the third quarter and managed to extend their lead to 15-9. In the final quarter both teams showed fantastic energy levels to continue to attack relentlessly, causing even more scoring opportunities which were converted into tries fantastically. We came away victorious with a score of 19-11.
