INTRODUCTION

Giving Notice for Paid Activities (e.g. Chess, Judo, Speech & Drama and Tennis)

During a school year, children will be expected to attend their chosen activities for a whole term and not start or stop at half term.

If you wish your child to stop a paid activity, we do respectfully ask for **written notice**. *This will be accepted before the half term (of any term) in order to allow your child to stop at the end of the term concerned.*

Rugby, Years 5 & 6: 4.00pm – 5.00pm

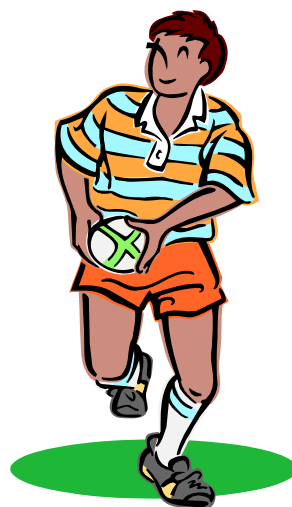
